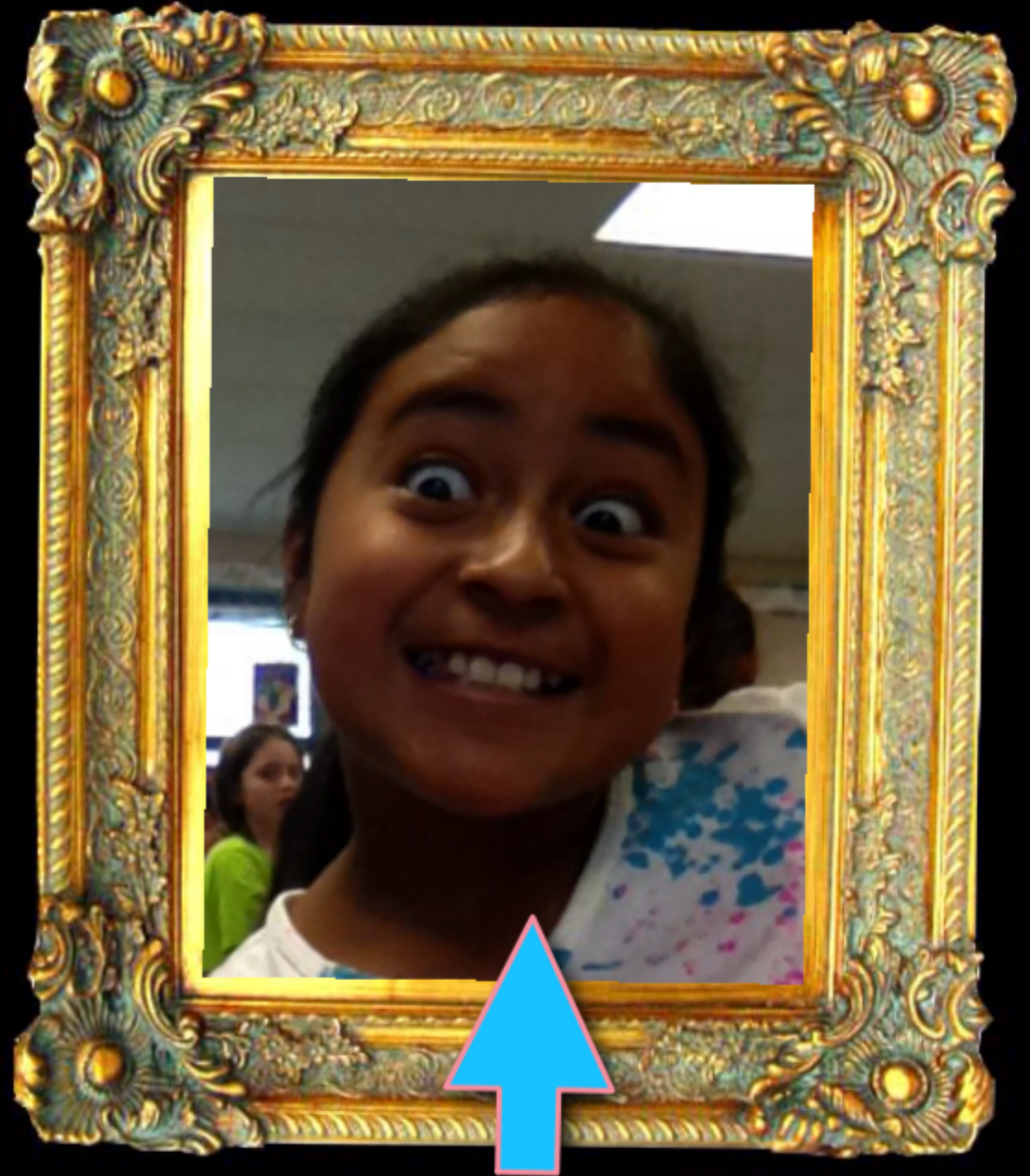


What we did
